A point in case are internationally recognised landmark projects located in Dubai, Seoul and Bangkok, where Terraco's Handycoat surface preparation projects are reaching new heights.

Terraco is proud to have been involved with the Burj Khalifa, Dubai, UAE, the tallest man-made structure in the world completed in 2009 which stands at 829.8 meters, supplying a variety of decorative wall finishes, as well as Handycoat to prepare interior surfaces prior to decoration.

Lotte World Tower is a 123-floor, 555-metre tall skyscraper currently under construction in the Lotte World complex in Seoul, South Korea. Once completed later in 2016, it will be the tallest building on the Korean peninsula, as well as the fourth tallest building in the world. Terraco's surface preparation product Handycoat Interior is being supplied.

The MahaNakhon Tower, at 314 metres with 77 floors will become the tallest building in Bangkok, Thailand once completed later in 2016. It is a luxury mixed-use skyscraper currently under construction in the Silom Central Business district of Bangkok. Terraco's ready-mix Handycoat Interior and dry-mix Maximix skimming and jointing compounds are being used extensively as interior surface preparation products. A unique feature is the pixelated facade, the glass curtain walled tower will have a cuboid-surfaced spiral cut into its side.

Terraco is today one of the largest producers of ready-mixed skimming, levelling, jointing, and skim coat plastering products.
